STUBE Niedersachsen provides students who show commitment to global development with support in preparing and funding a stay in their home country or in the region around it. The BPSA programme is meant to facilitate networking and the exchange of knowledge.

What can be funded:

- Research for a thesis or seminar paper (study visit)
- A study-related or vocationally relevant internship

Length of stay:

- At least four weeks
- No more than six months

Benefits:

- Cost coverage for transport up to € 1,780.--
- One-off travel allowance up to € 500.--
- Cost coverage for airfare of own children (\leq age 12)

Conditions for funding:

- Citizenship of a developing country (DAC list)
- Enrolment at a university in Niedersachsen
- Self-organised contact to the place of assignment
- Lack of own financial resources, no scholarship
- Previous attendance of STUBE events
