One-day field trip with a guided tour of the waste treatment facility in Hannover-Lahe

A clean environment is an important factor for a high quality of life and it is part of the global Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). In this context, the large global amount of waste is a problem. How can garbage be disposed of in a way that is as sustainable as possible?

In the Hannover district of Lahe, there is a modern waste treatment facility. An employee will show us various sections of it where different sorts of garbage are treated: the mechanical biological facility for residual waste, the composting plant for organic waste, the composting plant for green waste and a nearby landfill, which was filled up until 1982 and then revegetated. Known to many as Nordberg or „Monte Müll“, the former landfill is now an interesting recultivation project. Information on household waste recycling centres and the wastewater treatment plant is also on the programme.

We will meet at 9:00 h sharp at Hannover Hauptbahnhof (Hbf) in the basement in front of the entrance of the “Lidl” supermarket and go to Lahe together by underground train. Lunch will be offered there free of charge.

Important: Sturdy shoes and clothes for a ca. 30 minutes walk from the underground to the site
