Day trip to Bissendorf (Wedemark): Guided tour of the sewage treatment plant and workshop with experts from the field of climate protection management

Clean water and a clean environment are important factors for a high quality of life and they are part of the global Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). What is being done at the local level in order to reach these goals?

In Bissendorf (Wedemark) there is a modern sewage treatment plant where wastewater is cleaned and clean energy is produced simultaneously. Bacteria are deployed for a biological sewage treatment. Electric power is generated through residual sludge treatment and photovoltaic systems and immediately used for the sewage treatment process.

The excursion will lead us first from Bissendorf S-Bahn station to the sewage treatment plant. The director of „Wedemark Abwasser GmbH“ will show us the facility and explain how it works. From there we will walk further to the community centre „Bürgerhaus Bissendorf“, where we will have lunch and a workshop with experts who are in charge of climate protection management in the local authority of Wedemark. Finally we will have a look into a historic cavalier house in order to learn something about people’s way of living in earlier times.

We will meet at 9.30 h sharp at Hannover Hauptbahnhof (Hbf), upstairs on the platform at track 2.
